Tamworth Street Pavement Reconstruction Project (Fitzroy Street to Palmer Street)

Dubbo Regional Council (DRC) wishes to advise residents and local businesses that the Tamworth Street Pavement Reconstruction Project (Stage 1 - between Palmer Street and Taylor Street) is programmed for commencement on 11 March 2024.

These works are aimed at improving the pavement performance by complete reconstruction of the existing pavement. Council anticipates that these 'Stage 1' works will take approximately two (2) weeks to complete, weather permitting.

Council understands that these works may impact access to footpaths, driveways, and businesses. To minimise these impacts, Council plans to undertake these works in several sequential stages starting with only 'Stage 1' as shown in the attached project map.

During each work shift road closures will be required. These closures will be in place from 7 am to 4 pm. During these hours, residents will be able to access their properties under guidance by traffic controllers. Access to properties will initially be via Taylor Street with a road closure at Palmer Street. As works progress, this arrangement will be reversed with access via Palmer Street and a road closure at Taylor Street. Council will liaise with residents to provide prior notice of this change.

Please be advised that there will be some noise associated with these works, however, Council will endeavour to minimise the disturbance as much as possible.



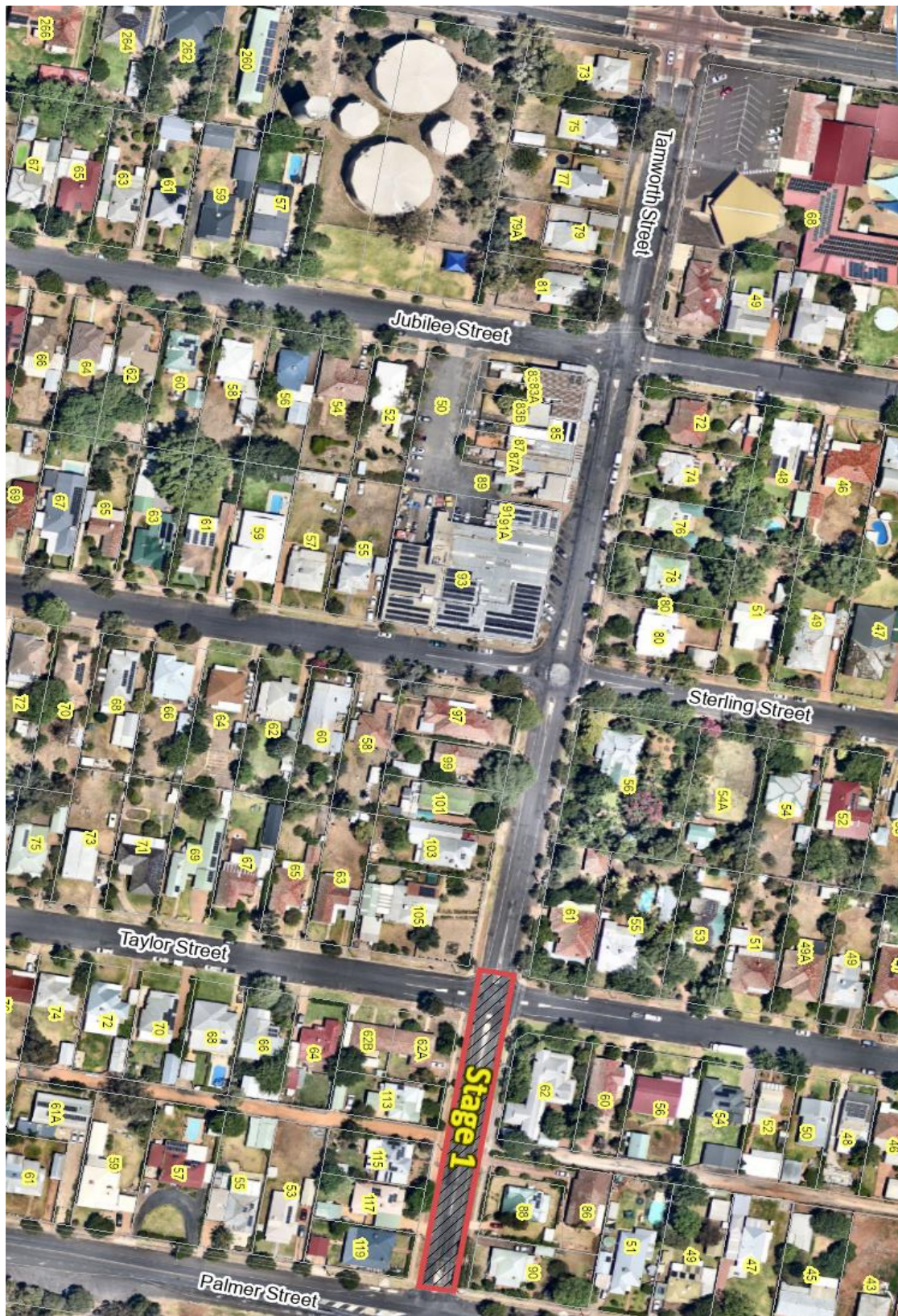
