## **Tamworth Street Pavement Reconstruction Project** (Fitzroy Street to Palmer Street)

Dubbo Regional Council (DRC) wishes to advise residents and local businesses that the Tamworth Street Pavement Reconstruction Project (Stage 7 - between Sterling Street and Taylor Street) is programmed for commencement on 19 March 2024.

These works are aimed at improving the pavement performance by complete reconstruction of the existing pavement. Council anticipates that these 'Stage 7' works will take approximately two (2) weeks to complete, weather permitting.

During each work shift road closures will be required. These closures will be in place from 7 am to 4 pm. The road will be re-opened to traffic at the conclusion of each shift.

Council understands that these works may impact access to footpaths, driveways, and businesses. Please be advised that there will be some noise associated with these works, however, Council will endeavour to minimise the disturbance as much as possible.
