Proposed Night Works Tamworth Street Subsoil Drainage Works (Sterling Street to Fitzroy Street)

Council wishes to advise residents and local businesses of Tamworth Street that subsoil drainage works are programmed for commencement on Monday, 14 August 2023, weather permitting.

These works are aimed at improving pavement drainage, which will in turn enable Council to undertake essential road reconstruction works of Tamworth Street at a later date. At this stage Council anticipates that the subsoil drainage works will take approximately two weeks to complete, weather permitting.

Please note that to minimize disruptions to residents and businesses along the road, Council wishes to undertake these works as **NIGHT WORK** from 6.00 pm in the evening to 4.00 am in the morning. The works will be conducted in four sequential stages until the job is finished, with the aim of minimizing disruptions to roadway, footpath, and pedestrian access, and to ensure that the road can be reopened the following day.

During each work shift, travel lane closures will be required. These travel lanes will be re-opened to traffic at the conclusion of the shifts. These travel lane closures will be required progressively at Tamworth Street, Jubilee Street and Sterling Street.

Council also wishes to notify residents that there will be some noise associated with these works, however, Council will endeavour to minimise the disturbance to residents. Council acknowledges the inconvenience these works may cause and thank you for your continued understanding during these infrastructure improvement works.
